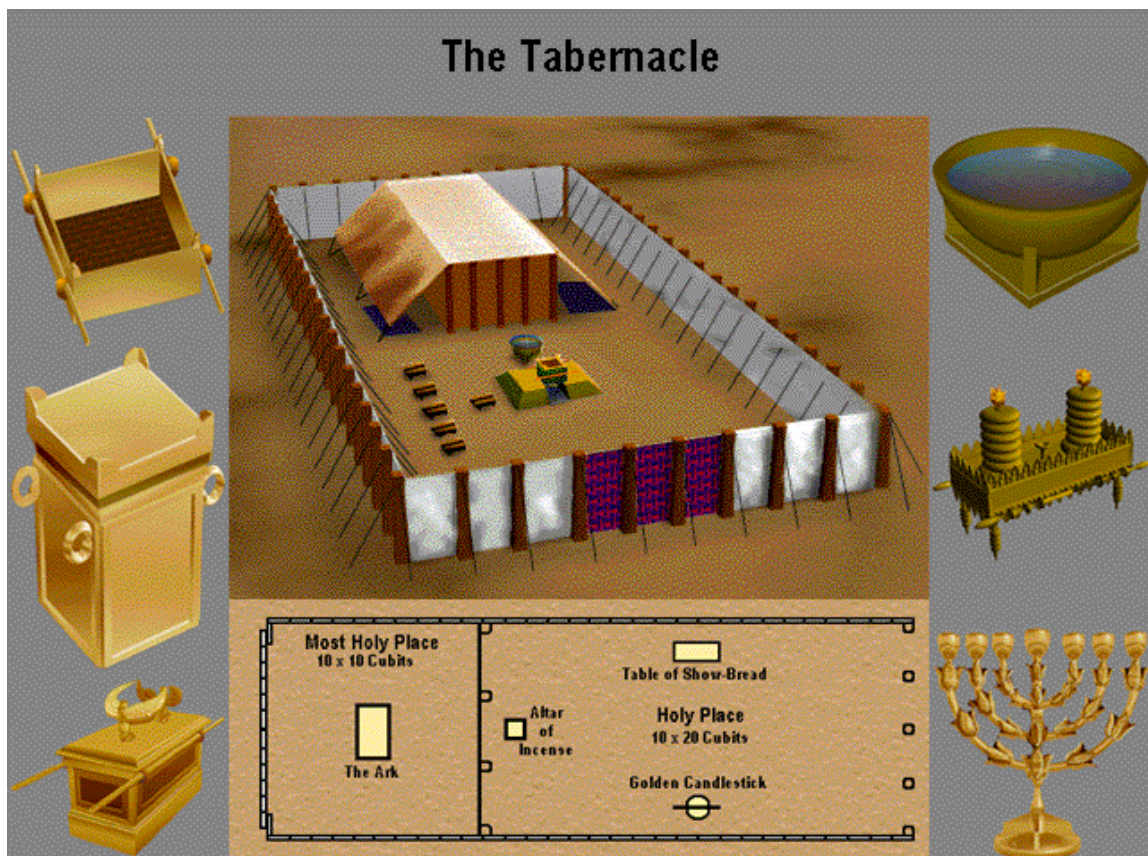




## Hebrews 9 -10

1. Read Hebrews 9:1-10 and Exodus 24:12-25:9, Hebrews 8:5. What was the origin and purpose of this structure? What evidence do you find in these verses that it is a “typological” structure?
2. Our God is an interior designer! He was very specific in His instructions about the furnishings that would be in the earthly Tabernacle. Reread Hebrews 9:1-10, linger over what is described and how it relates to the diagram below. What differences do you notice in the furnishings and activities that were in this God designed dwelling place and the one where you worship weekly?



**Note:** Remember that atonement means reparation that reconciles and brings into harmony those who have been enemies and separated from one another. It is easy to remember it as being brought into “at-one-ment.”

**3. Read Leviticus 16 and Leviticus 17:10-11.** After reading these verses, explain the ways that you see the truth that God gave the sacrificial laws with Jesus in mind.

**4. Read Hebrews 9:11 – 10:18.** Create a comparison chart that shows how Christ and the True Tabernacle are superior to the Aaronic priests and the Earthly Tabernacle.

**Note:** It is possible to be knowledgeable about all the furnishings in the Tabernacle, the Old Testament sacrificial system and to intellectually know why Christ’s sacrifice is superior to all that went before and still not understand how those doctrines applied to your own life. Let us press on to application of the lessons!

**5. Read Hebrews 10:19-39.** With the repetition of 4 “Let us...” phrases, how does the author want us to apply the doctrines? What do you find familiar in verses 26-39?

**6.** With the truths of Hebrews 9-10 in your mind, write a prayer to God expressing what you are most grateful for.
